

Fraction Race

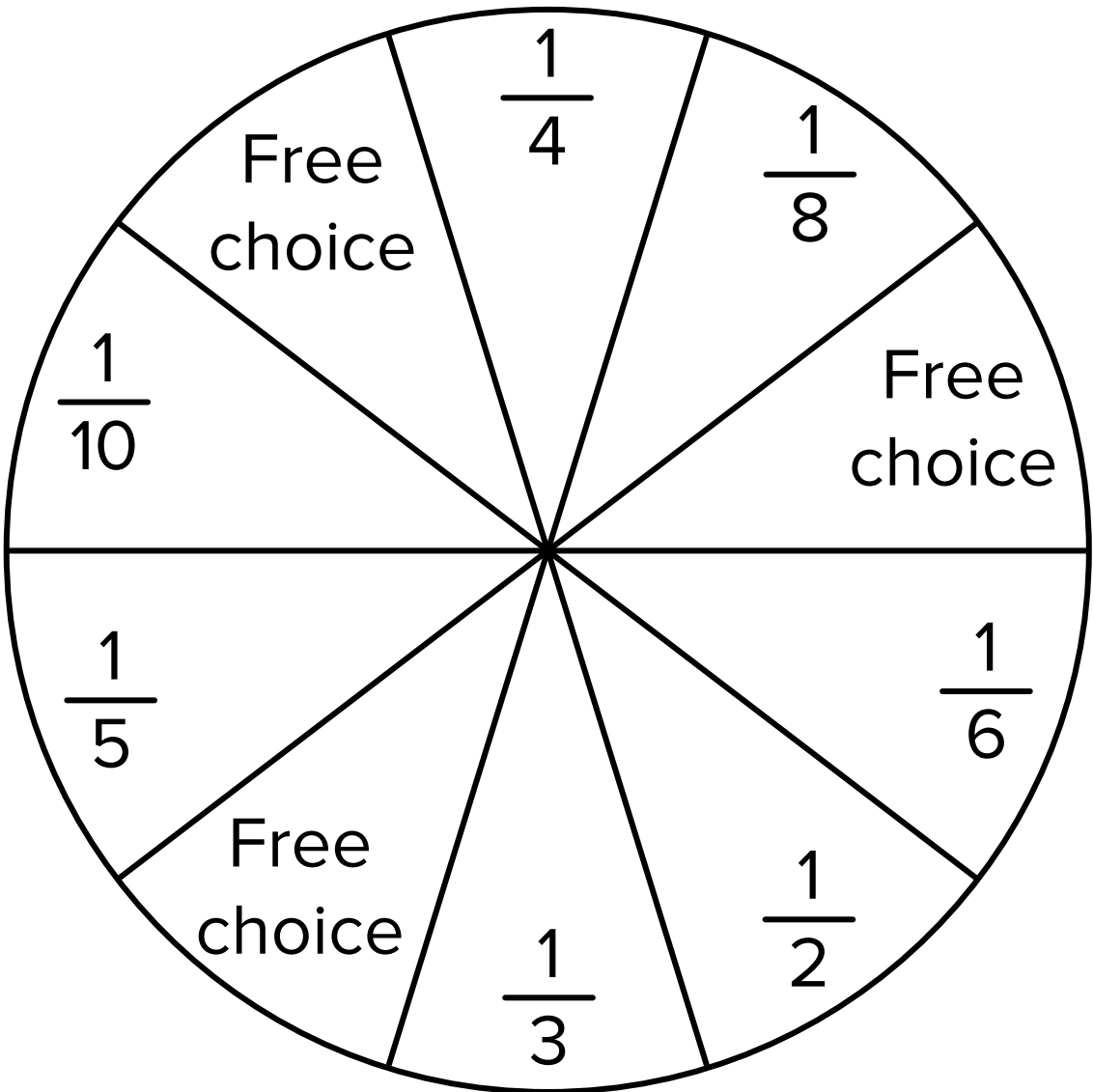
Preparation:

- Print pages 3 to 11 for each player playing the Fraction Race game
- Cut out and laminate the fraction pieces
- Put all the fraction pieces in a container ready to play the game
- Print out and laminate the spinner on page 2
- Put a spinner in the middle or get a pencil and paper clip to use as a spinner

Aim: Fill in the circles with fraction pieces to make 4 wholes.

How to play:

- Use a pencil and paper clip or spinner to spin a fraction.
- Take a fraction piece and put it on one of the circles.
- Rearrange the fractions as needed each turn to make a whole circle.
- First person to make 4 whole circles is the winner.
- Be careful not to overlap any fraction, if they overlap they do not add up to a whole. $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{5}$ can be difficult to distinguish, remind students to look closely



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
