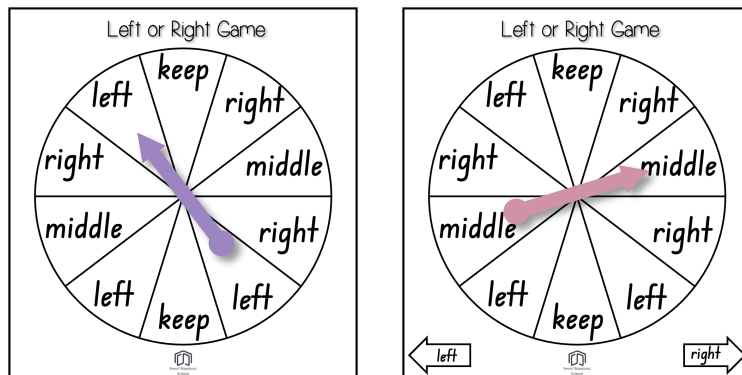


# Left or Right Game

Practise left and right understanding with this simple and engaging game. It is best played in a small group but can work with a whole class.

Print page 2 or 3 on card or laminate so it is sturdy. Put a spinner in the middle or use a paper clip and pencil.



Ask the students to sit in a circle. Give each student 3 items (counters, pencils, pompoms or match sticks).

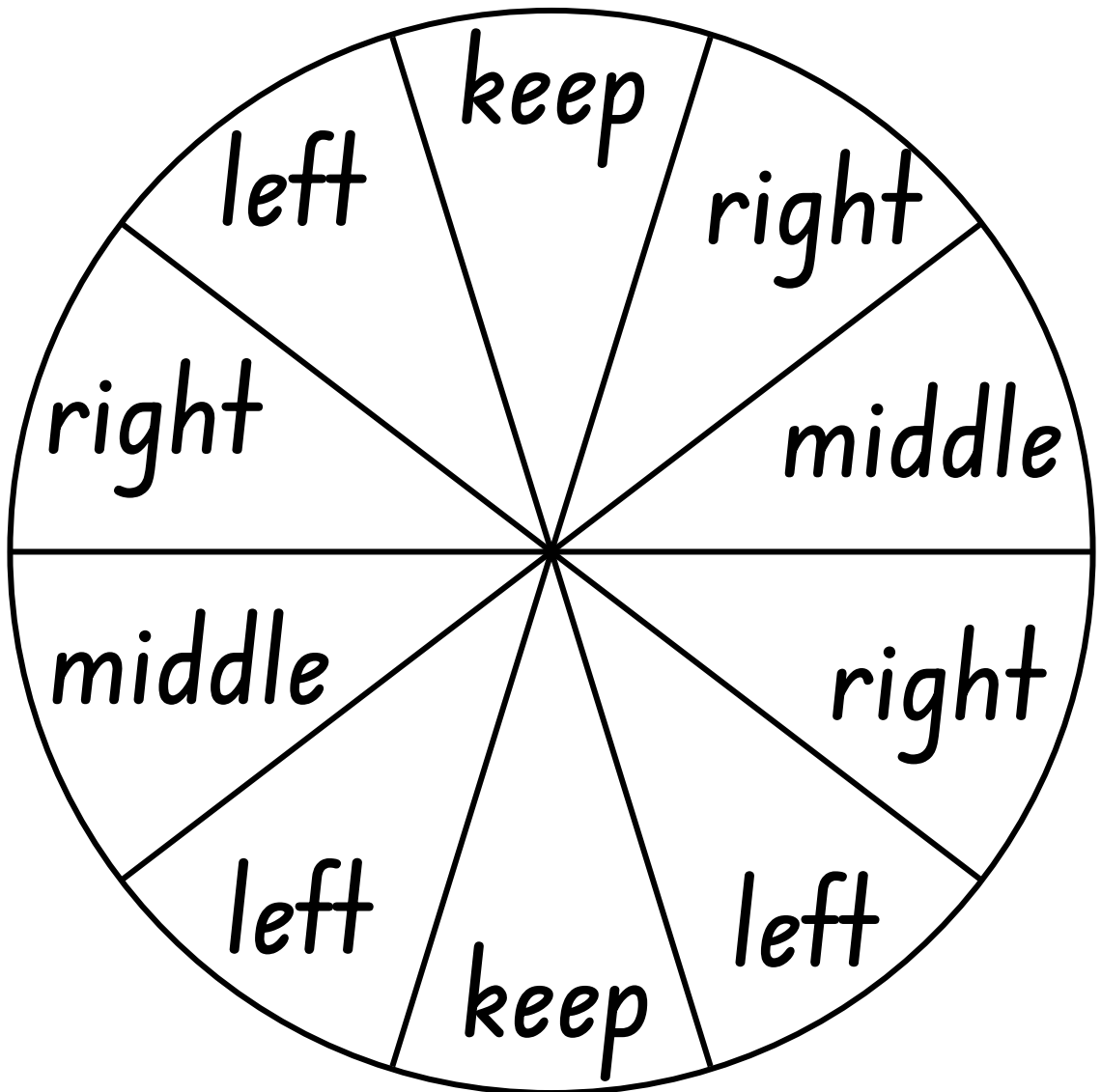
The first student spins the spinner and moves 1 of their 3 items according to what was spun:

- Left – give 1 item to the person sitting on the left
- Right – give 1 item to the person sitting on the right
- Middle – put an item in the middle of the circle, that item is now stuck in the middle and cannot be used again.
- Keep – keep the item, nothing gets moved.

The spinner is then passed to the next student and repeated around the circle.

The winner is the student with the last item still in front of them or the student with most items left after a given length of time.
